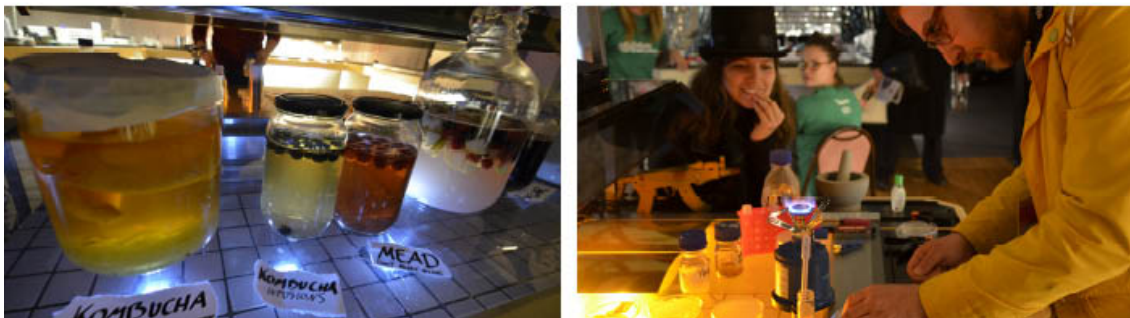

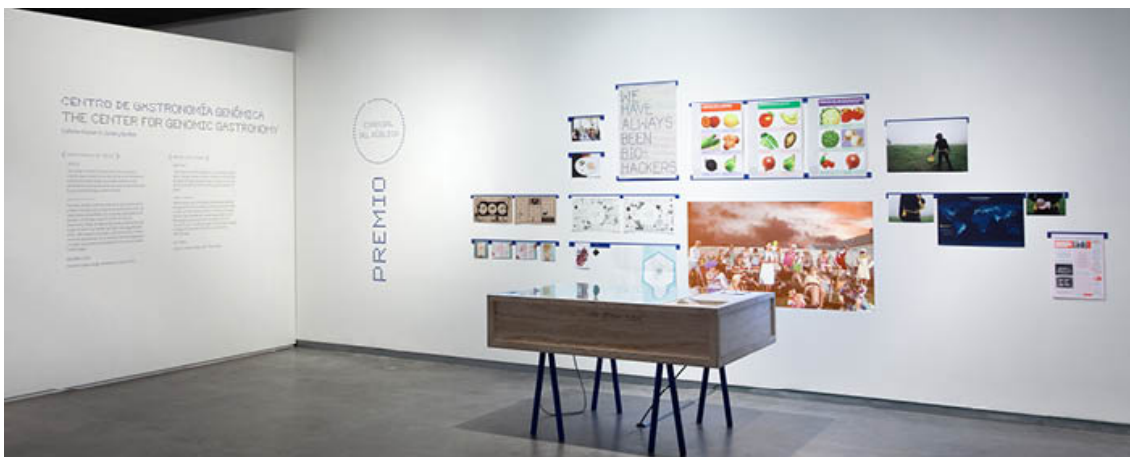
Hello! We've had a busy spring and are excited to share some of our most recent activities with you.

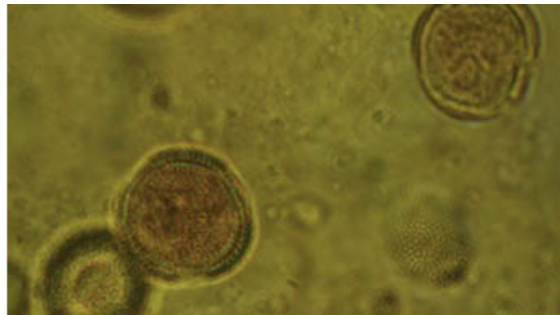




## VIDA 15.0

The Center ran a two day Culinary Forensics workshop and participated in ArtMeatFlesh 4 at Aalto University in Helsinki, Finland. The three-part workshop included honey analysis, DNA fingerprinting, and gluten testing with students at Aalto Biofilia. ArtMeatFlesh 4 explored the future of meat consumption. The event was hosted by Oron Catts, while Cat and Zack paired with Finnish food experts and battled each other iron-chef style.
